Dear Parent/Guardian:

In order to assist the school in determining the health needs of your child, please complete the attached forms and return them to the Health Office.

Health History Form

The health history requests information that will be beneficial in assisting the school with the health status of the student.

This form must be completed before the student can start school. Please include all immunization dates required. Provide proof of dates from doctor, medical clinic, or previous school records.

If this form cannot be completed at this time, please return completed form to the Health Office as soon as possible.

Medical Examination Form

The Pennsylvania School Health Code mandates medical examinations for students on original entry to a school and in grades 6 and 11. Any student transferring from out of state is required to have a physical exam. If a student is transferring from within the State of Pennsylvania, a physical exam is needed only if there is no record of one on the permanent health record. The purpose of the examination is to insure that the student is in a general state of good health. It has been recognized that there is a direct correlation between the health status of a student and the student's cognitive development and performance.

The physical examination may be done by the student's private physician (please have physician fill out attached form and return to the health office) or by the school physician. **If the exam is done by your private physician, the form must be returned to the health office before the first day of school.**

Dental Exam Form

Dental examinations on original entry to school, grades 3 and 7 are mandated by the State of Pennsylvania.

The dental examination may be done by the student's private dentist (please have dentist fill out attached form and return to the health office) or by the school dentist. **If the exam is done by your private dentist, the form must be returned to the health office before the first day of school.**
