7th Grade Homerooms:

- 2 boxes of tissues
- Either bottle of sanitizer or disinfecting wipes
- Pencils/Pens (blue or black)
- Highlighters
- Colored pencils, markers, glue sticks & crayons

8th Grade Homerooms:

- 2 boxes of tissues

7th & 8th Grade Science:

8th Grade Religion:

- 2" Binder
- Loose leaf paper

- 1 pack of binder dividers
- Blue or Black and Red Pens

8th Grade English/Reading

- 1 notebook
- 1 packet of loose leaf paper
- 1 - binder (1 inch) any color
- Assorted post-it notes
- Assorted highlighters
- 3 x 5 index cards
- Blue or black pens
- Colored pencils or gel pens assorted colors

7th & 8th Grade Spanish:

- 1 ½-2" binder with Loose leaf paper
- 3 subject dividers
- 15-20 clear page protectors
- Large or jumbo book cover

7th & 8th Grade Math:

- 1- 2 pocket folder
- 5 sheets graph paper 8 ½ x 11, 3 hold punched, 20 lb (Five Star recommended). 7th grade 4 squares per inch, 8th grade 4 or 5 squares per inch.
- Smallest possible zipped pouch containing:
 - (2) pencils, No. 2, sharpened with clean erasers
 - Small, good quality pencil sharpener that can be used over the wastebasket
 - (1) medium ballpoint pen with blue ink
 - 6-inch ruler, hard plastic, inches on one side (markings showing 1/16"), centimeters on the other (markings showing millimeters)
 - Protractor – 1 piece, clear hard plastic with 4" (or 6") ruler, smaller is better, markings showing each of 180 degrees in both directions
 - Compass with pencil (Charles Leonard & Staidtler are good names)
- To keep at home:
 - Large supply of graph paper
 - 4-inch, 3 ring binder for exclusively math
