It is time to start planning for the Family Fish Fry events! They are held every Friday of Lent except Good Friday in the LeGras Parish Center. This is an opportunity for members of our parish, school, and surrounding community to share food, fellowship, and fun to benefit the school.

The Fish Fry events require a large number of volunteers. Many of our committed individuals come back to serve year after year.
